The Father Edward Donovan Memorial Scholarship is an arm of the JFM College Scholarship Fund. This scholarship awards one undergraduate student a \$2,000 scholarship and an opportunity to undertake a paid summer internship with CVHC. Award selection is based on the student's demonstrated leadership qualities and commitment to community service. Past recipients are not eligible.

A Complete Fr. Edward Donovan Memorial Scholarship Application Must Include:

- CERTIFICATION - Letter of Verification certifying your community service from the organization/agency with which you volunteer (40 or more volunteer community service hours in the last 12 months)
- Maintain a 3.00 GPA or better
- VI. ESSAY - Your personal statement essay
- VII. ESSAY - Your personal statement essay for the CVHC impact
- VIII. ESSAY - Your personal statement essay response for the Father Edward Donovan Scholarship Opportunity;
- TRANSCRIPT - A copy of your unofficial high school -or- college/university transcript; first-year college students, please include a copy of your Letter of Acceptance;
- UTILITY BILL - Copy of utility bill with CVHC address (water or electric bill).
